

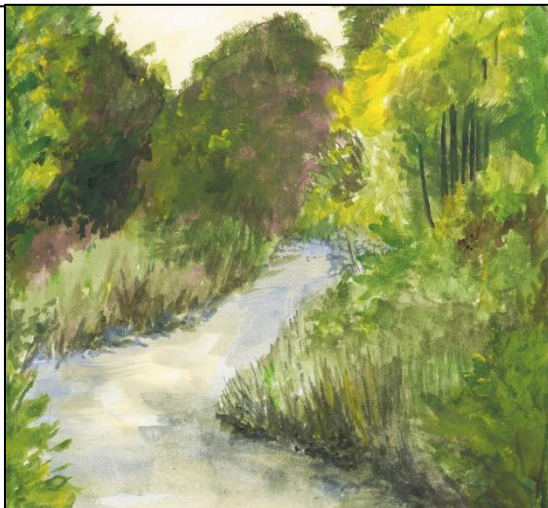
ARBOR DAY FAMILY FUN
